

BYLAW NO. 5/2011

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF NORQUAY TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF SEWER

COUNCIL of the Town of Norquay, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Municipality's water supply system and sewer services shall make application to the officials of the Municipality.
2. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached whether or not any water is consumed.
3. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
4. Every customer shall pay a utility infrastructure fee of \$50.00 per quarter effective starting with the October, 2011 utility billing.
5. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of three months, payable in advance. Accounts shall be paid on or before the first day of the month next following the billing period (the next billing date) or shall be subject to a penalty as set out in Clause 7. If an account remains in arrears within a period of thirty days after the next billing date, the water service may be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be turned on until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of **\$50.00** to cover the expenses of turning off the water and turning it on again; provided that if it is required to turn on the water service outside the employees' regular working hours, the fee shall be **\$100.00**.
6. Persons who request a water disconnect shall pay a fee of **\$25.00** and another **\$25.00** at the time of re-connection.
7. A penalty of 5% shall be applied to all unpaid utility accounts not paid on or before the first day of the month next following the billing period.
8. The municipality shall have the right to ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any or all consumers, should the circumstances seem to warrant such action.
9. Bylaw No. 6/2010 is hereby repealed.

THE rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.
